


Geography


The socio-economic catchment profile is based on two distinct geographies. Firstly, the official settlement boundary for the town (based on Central Statistics Office definition) and secondly, a drive-time isochrone or travel catchment to each settlement. Two isochrones are represented here - a 0-30 minute travel isochrone and a one-hour travel isochrone (see green and blue areas below).

Within a one hour drivetime there is a total working age population of 157,045. This figure represents approximately 3.6% of the All-Island working age population (4.317M) in 2016.





There are 22,887 graduates with a Third Level Degree residing within a one hour drive from the settlement. 26.8% have a PostGrad and 1.6% have a PhD




Ballyconnell has a high number of people with Apprenticeships, Technical and Vocational qualifications residing within a one hour drive from the settlement.









Within the Settlement a population of 389 are non-native language speakers. This can be broken down into Polish 219 (56.3%), French 7 (1.8%), Lithuanian 54 (13.9%) and Other 109 (28%).










Resident Workers and Locally based Jobs




Where are Ballyconnell resident workers (703) employed?

Destination of Ballyconnell Residents Workers - by Settlement




Ballyconnell based Jobs - where do workers come from? (903)

There are 703 people residing in the Ballyconnell settlement area who are classed as being 'At Work'. Of these workers, a total of 46% (320) are employed in Ballyconnell, 22% (157) are employed elsewhere in Cavan, 18% (126) commute out of the county for employment and the remaining 14% (100) are either Mobile workers or have a blank or un-codeable destination.



In total, there are 903 jobs located within the Ballyconnell settlement. Of these, 35% (320) are undertaken by local residents living in Ballyconnell, 51% (458) are undertaken by workers living elsewhere in Cavan county (see Map on following page) and the remaining 14% (125) are undertaken by workers who commute to Ballyconnell from outside the county.





Profile of Locally based Jobs (Ballyconnell)




Age Profile of Workers







According to POWCAR 2016, there are 903 jobs based in Ballyconnell. This accounts for 4.4% of all jobs based in the county. Although 40% of the resident workers in Ballyconnell are employed elsewhere (see previous page), Ballyconnell is the employment destination for 583 workers from outside the settlement. The town is a net importer of jobs (+200).


