This promises to be an unforgettable night recreating one of the most unique aspects of the Irish emigrant experience.




PERCY FRENCH CENTENARY CONCERT

A special tribute concert will celebrate the life and work of Percy French, one of Ireland's foremost songwriters and entertainers. Percy French made Cavan his home for seven years from 1881 to 1888, taking up residence in Farnham Street, where he wrote some of his best songs. The evening will include such favourites as 'Phil the Fluther's Ball', 'The Mountains of Mourne' and, of course, 'Come Back, Paddy Reilly, to Ballyjamesduff' in what promises to be a nostalgic and enchanting evening of music and song, with audience participation encouraged.

'IN ANXIOUS EXPECTATION' ANCESTRY EVENT

Cavan Genealogy will host a two-day ancestry event called 'In Anxious Expectation', which will explore themes of emigration and immigration both past and current. The event will also feature an exhibition documenting the County Cavan emigration experience, genealogy workshops and an evening of music, poetry, song and dance will follow the first day of the conference.
