






Social Media Tips


Graphic Design


Free Music

Add Links to your Social Media

When you look at a bio in Instagram or Twitter you don't want to have to many links there and so a great tool is Linktree which lets audiences connect to all of your content with just one link. "A Linktree not only points followers in the direction of your choosing — to your other social profiles, eCommerce store, or content you want to share — but it helps hold followers within your online ecosystem for longer. It allows users to share more, sell more, curate more and grow more".

Shorten your URLs

Sometimes when you are limited to the amount of characters that you can use and you want to share a URL then it's a great idea to shorten the URL.

What Bitly does is it takes longer URLs (which can be over a hundred characters long) and transform them into manageable links that almost never exceed 20 characters and so saving space.

(once you enter Bitly scroll down and you will see a space to enter the URL you want to shorten).



What is your Website Ranking?

Have you ever wondered how many hits your competitors' websites are getting? Well you can check it out using a website called Similar Web. It's a great way to compare your reach against others.

This tool allows you to really see what's going on, on what is a very busy platform making the time you spend researching and engaging on the platform much more efficient.






Photo Size Matters

Sending Large Flles


Have you ever wanted to send large files by email but you can't? Most email will only let you send files up to 25MB and this is where Wetransfer comes in so handy.




Edit Photos on your Phone
